Subject: Measures Relevant to UTCC Students

Due to The Effect of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Pandemic

Pursuant to the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation Announcement regarding the measures to support people affected by the spread of the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) dated 12 March 2020, along with the Announcement on Vigilant Measures against the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) (No. 3): Practices for Higher Education Institutions to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 dated 17 March 2020, and the Announcement of Bangkok Metropolitan Administration entitled Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 2) dated 21 March 2020 and (No. 4) dated 27 March 2020, UTCC President, by virtue of Section 43 (1), (5), (11) and (13) of Private Institute of Higher Education Act, B.E. 2546, Revision (No.2), B.E. 2550, hereby issues the following measures:

1. The temporary closure of UTCC shall be extended. The original closure period until 12 April 2020 shall be extended to 30 April 2020.
2. All schools shall revise the Academic Year 2019 final examination arrangement for all academic programs including practical courses, at all levels (bachelor's, master's, and Ph.D.) to be online assessment. Instructors can adopt various approaches of online examinations, for instance, open-book tests, take-home exams, individual/ group reports, online oral examination, report presentation using Webex Meeting, testing via Electronic Exams or CBA (Computer-Based Assessment), or any other appropriate forms of assessment.
3. As UTCC has to be temporarily closed and arrange all courses online for the second semester, Academic Year 2019 from 22 March 2020 to 30 April 2020, those students who already enrolled for the second semester are thus unable to access facilities and services on campus. In this regard, UTCC is considering refunding partial facility fees to students due to the suspension of such services. Details on the refund rules and procedures will be further notified.

For the summer enrollment, Academic Year 2019, students can basically enroll according to the academic calendar. Should there be any problems during the enrollment, please contact UTCC Office of the Registrar via online channels.
